## How long is the EMT program?

Our program is approximately 4 months. Our 30 years of experience has shown that a faster course or online course decreases the retention volume needed to move forward to paramedic or nursing programs. The book is over 1,800 pages and does not account for the knowledge obtained at the required skill lab sessions and clinicals. We do occasionally offer a condensed schedule for the participant who has plenty of free time to study and above average learning skills.

  - **DO NOT TAKE THE SUMMER COURSE BECAUSE IT IS ONLY A 2.5 MONTH PROGRAM. THIS IS A FAST-PACED COURSE AND YOU NEED TIME TO DO HOMEWORK AND STUDY.**
  - Meets on every Saturday from 8:30am to 4:30pm.
  - Meets on every other Mondays from 6pm to 10pm starting June 3<sup>rd</sup>.
  - On average there is 8 hours of required homework assignments per week.

- **START DATE: June 24, 2024 END DATE: November 7, 2024**
  - Meets on Monday and Thursday evenings 6pm to 10pm FOR THE FIRST TWO WEEKS.
  - Starting after July 10<sup>th</sup>, class will only be on Thursday evenings + the following 2 Saturdays on Sept 14<sup>th</sup> and Sept 28<sup>th</sup> from 8:30am to 4:30pm.
  - Holiday/No Class: July 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>
  - On average there is 5 hours of required homework assignments per week.

#### Prerequisites:

- 18 years of age or older.
  - If less than 18 years of age you can attend class and become NREMT certified. You will not become TxDSHS (state) certified until turning 18 years of age.
- High school diploma or GED at a minimum.
  - You can attend class and become NREMT certified prior to obtaining a diploma or GED. You will not become TxDSHS (state) certified until providing proof of diploma or GED.
- Limited criminal history. If applicable, contact school to discuss.
- Reliable internet service for online assignments and homework.

#### Cost:

- \$1,325 and includes tuition, textbooks, lab & clinical fees, clinical polo, clinical liability insurance \$1m/\$5m, and AHA BLS certification.
- Does not include:
  - State certification and National Registry of EMT (NREMT) testing fees due upon completion of course. These fees are typical of any EMT program upon completion. NREMT exam fee \$104, TxDSHS certification \$64, FACT criminal history and fingerprinting \$38.
  - Immunizations, if not current. Call school for assistance so you do not overpay.
  - Drug testing fee \$40. The school will schedule a drug test during a random class session.

#### Deposit to Secure Seat in Program and Financial Aid Information?

- A deposit of half down secures your seat in the class.
- All students must register with the first half of the program costs. The remaining balance is typically due at the first class session. An approved payment plan for the second half of course fees must be submitted prior to the start date. Contact our office for specifics.
- EMTS is approved by the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA).
- EMTS is a vocational school and not Title IV which is government funding eligible.
