



Registration Updates for BLS for the Healthcare Provider - CPR Marathon

YOU MUST REGISTER WITH YOUR CHILDREN'S NATIONAL EMAIL ADDRESS

In an attempt to meet the demand for BLS recertification in-house, we will be modifying the 2015 Marathon schedule:

- Two sessions (7a & 4p) will offer the option of watching the video **OR** completing the online portion.
- Three sessions will be offered that will **only** be skills (10a; 12N; 4p). If you enroll in one of these sessions, you **must** complete the didactic portion online. There will **NOT** be a video offered during these sessions.

0700 – 1000	Video or Online Certificate
1000 – 1200	Online certificate only (Register for Skills Only Session)
1200 – 1400	Online certificate only (Register for Skills Only Session)
1400 – 1600	Online certificate only (Register for Skills Only Session)
1600 – 1900	Video or Online Certificate

Online Key Codes:

- For those who wish to complete the didactic portion online, information concerning key codes will be sent **NOT LATER THAN** one (1) week before the scheduled class date.
- **You must register with your CNMC email. Keycodes will ONLY be sent to CNMC email addresses.**
- The American Heart Association will send out the email with instructions for accessing your key code.

Course Description:

This is a 3-hour American Heart Association Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Providers recertification course and your BLS card must be current to attend. This is not an initial certification class for the Healthcare Provider Course.

This classroom course is for Healthcare Providers who need to maintain their cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certification, as well as other lifesaving skills. It includes a cognitive portion (Part 1) and skills practice and testing (Parts 2 & 3). You will be required to pass both a written (or online) test and a skills assessment.

- You have the option of taking the cognitive portion (Part 1) online which includes the course exam. If you do not wish to complete the cognitive portion online, you must watch the video in class and take the written test.
- Key codes will be sent out to all participants NOT LATER THAN one (1) week before the scheduled class start date. Key codes will only be supplied to those who register with their CNMC email address.
