Q: How many modules are there?

A: There are 5 online modules including the following:

- Chapter 4: Biomechanics, Kinematics, and Mechanisms of Injury
- Chapter 16: Special Populations: The Pregnant Trauma Patient
- Chapter 18: Special Populations: The Older Adult Trauma Patient
- Chapter 19: Special Populations: The Bariatric Trauma Patient
- Chapter 20: Special Populations: The Interpersonal Violence Trauma Patient

Q: Is there a final exam online?

A: There is no final exam online; all exams will be given in the classroom setting.

Q: I don't have an access code to enter for TNCC, who do I contact?

Apple iOS:

Articulate Mobile Player; Apple iOS 5.0 or later on iPad

Q: Can I exit out of the module, and then come back later to pick up where I left off?
